

How to Make a Traditional Story

Making a traditional story is easy enough if you have the right ingredients. You should follow the steps listed below and if you do, you too can invent stories to keep your friends amazed and amused.

What you need: a farmer's daughter, a forest, a prince, a castle, an axe, night time, a wolf.

What you do:

1. First place the farmer's daughter alone in the forest.
2. Next boil the story gently as the prince looks out of the castle window and sees the girl.
3. After that add in the prince picking up an axe and going to find her.
4. Then stir in night and a hungry wolf.
5. Leave the story to cook for a while.
6. Now introduce a pinch of excitement by letting the wolf seize the girl!
7. Finally finish the story off by sprinkling in the prince, the axe and a sad end for the wolf!

As you can see, it doesn't take much to make a traditional tale. Of course, if the tale is to last then it will need that final, special ingredient – your imagination!

Extra tips:
Add in a layer of complication by letting the prince lose his way!

Further suggested ingredients:
A lonely giant, a spiteful guard, a deep lake and something scary living in a cave in the middle of the forest.
