- Being introduced to our Author Focus for this half term of Kes Gray and enjoying some of his stories.
- Starting our 'Daily Mile' run. We will be building up to doing this several times a week over the term.
- Finding out about Harvest, what it is and how Christians say thank you to God.
- Thinking about the importance of 'Kind Hands' in our PSHE circle times.

Reading

Your child received their first reading book this week. Please get them to make up their own story from the pictures to explain what is happening. This phase in reading is all about interpreting pictures and developing your child's language. The children need to explain what is happening in sentences. Do not take for granted that your child knows what a bus stop, lost property office or library is. Your child may not have had first-hand experiences of visiting these places, so you will need to explain what these are. Acting out scenarios through role-play would be really helpful if you are unable to visit these places for the concrete experiences. Thank you.
