Understanding the World	 The more practise of this that children have, the quicker they will master the numbers. If your child is working on 1-5 or 1-10, do the same activity but focus on what they do know with a few that they still need to learn. Continue to practise 'subtraction' in a practical way. You can also say 'take-away'. Use anything you have a home, such as cars, spoons or bottle tops. Start with 5 objects. Say that you are going to subtract 1. Can your child visually see what would be left? If not, physically remove 1 object. Your child counts what is left. Say aloud 5 subtract 1 leaves 4. Repeat frequently until your child is confident that subtraction always leaves less and can start to use the language to explain what you are doing. Our New Topic is 'Let's Celebrate'. We will be learning about the range of different celebrations from different cultures over the next half-term. This week coincides with Bonfire Night. You may like to tell the story behind this, or concentrate on the safety aspect. Both powerpoint
