We will look at 'Being Me in my World' and then thinking about how to celebrate our differences.

Science

In Science we will be exploring materials and how their properties make them suitable for different purposes, particularly exploring which materials are most suitable for a shelter.

Maths

We will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction and money. Reasoning will be used to solve mathematical problems and to explain our thinking.

English

History

Throughout the term we will be learning all about The Great Fire of London and the impact this significant event had on Britain.

PE
