



We will be reading the book "Storm" in **Literacy** to inspire our narrative writing and we will also be writing some very useful instructions!

Year 3 will be appraising, singing and playing instruments to the song "Let your spirit fly".

Our topic in **Science** is called *Food and our Bodies*. To start with, we will learn about human teeth and digestion, before moving on to studying animal diets.

In **RE**, Year 3 will be studying the concept of rites of passage across religious and non-religious world views. They will also be learning about the Trinity.

In **Computing**, Year 3 will be creating PowerPoints and learning how to use Word.

In outdoor **PE**, the children will be developing their skills in throwing and catching as well as participating in a range of ball games. For our indoor unit, we will be using our bodies in different ways.

In **Maths** this term, Year 3 will be working on place value of 3-digit numbers as well as focusing on four basic mathematical operations.

Our topic for **History** is called *Exciting Egyptians!* There is certainly plenty to learn, including: the process of mummification, hieroglyphics and the many Egyptian gods.

In **Art**, children will make a self-portrait. They will look at images in Ancient Egyptian drawings and paintings and investigate a range of drawing materials, techniques and colour mixing.

In the second half term, the children will be making Shadufs for their **DT** project. A Shaduf was an Egyptian pulley mechanism used to lift heavy loads, especially water from the River Nile.

In **PSHE**, we will first be thinking about extended relationship networks beyond our families. After half term, we will be celebrating our differences.

In **Geography**, the children will be focusing on the importance of the oceans and environmental issues.

In **French**, the children will be gaining an introduction to a new language. They will be learning greetings, colours and other useful vocabulary.
