## Caterpillar and Ladybird Classes

We will be settling into school routines and getting to know each other. We will be learning to access resources and the areas of the classroom independently. Finding out about our 'Reward Jar' and voting for a special treat.

For our maths we will be learning about matching, sorting and comparing objects. The children will be thinking about similarities and differences to help them sort objects by their own criteria. They will be using the language of more and fewer when comparing amounts.

They will move on to comparing object by size, mass and capacity. They will be using the language of taller, shorter, smaller, bigger and longer. We will be continuing simple patterns and then creating some of their own two step patterns e.g. red, blue, red, blue or stick, leaf, stick, leaf



We will have the opportunity to undertake a variety of fine motor activities to develop healthy hands, such as threading, using tweezers, tracing, using malleable materials and tools.

In our **RE** we will be looking at 'What is my place in the world?'
