

In Mathematics, we will be studying shape, angles, position and directions, decimals, and measurement. We will also be revising skills learnt so far, this academic year.

In Literacy, we are moving onto looking at narratives from other cultures, focusing on *Oranges in No Man's Land*. Furthermore, we will explore non-chronological reports.

We will be studying two topics this term in Science. The first is entitled 'Electrifying' in which we will look at circuits. The second is 'Out of This World' in which the children will learn about space.

In RE, the children will be answering the enquiry question 'How do Hindus make sense of the world?' we will be continuing with developing our understanding of Christianity where the children will look at the Kingdom of God and Pentecost.

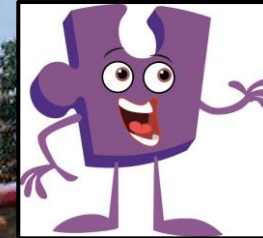
Our topic in Computing is 'We Are Architects' where the children will understand how to construct a virtual room on TinkerCAD. We will also be looking at different forms of social media

In Geography, we will be answering the question, 'Why does population change?' We will also look at London Landmarks and their locations.

Indoors, we will be developing our skills in Volleyball and Yoga. Meanwhile, in outdoor PE, we will be covering Athletics and Cricket.

In Art and DT this term, the children will create a fabric London landscape, using a variety of sewing techniques and different paint effects on the fabric.
