

Maths

This term we will be working on comparing, ordering and rounding decimals and solving problems using money. Next we will focus on time and then we will be interpreting and presenting data using line graphs. We will be exploring angles and describing position on a grid.



Science

Our focus this term will be plants, investigating the functions of parts of a plant and seed dispersal. We will also be grouping living things using classification keys.

P.E Our focus this term is rounders, athletics and fitness. The children will be developing throwing, catching, bowling and field skills. They will learn the rules of rounders by playing games. Linking to the Olympic games we will be focusing on athletics too.

Music

We will be learning about the Beatles. We will continue to learn to play the recorder.



Geography/History

In geography, we will look at the location of Greece, climate and tourism. In history, we will be finding out about Ancient Greek life, religion, stories, heroes and the influences and legacy they left behind.
