Enquiry 3: How do Christians belong to their faith family?		
Children:	Examples:	
MUST • Identify key information about Christianity • Recognise that people belong to different groups and communities • Identify ways Christians show they belong to their faith family • Ask questions about how belonging is shown in Christian life	Name key information about Christianity: ○ God (one God) ○ place of worship (church) ○ holy book (Bible) ○ followers (Christians) ○ founder (Jesus Christ) • Identify groups they belong to, such as clubs, teams or school, and recognise that Christians belong to a church or faith family • Refer to ways Christians show belonging, such as baptism, attending church, using symbols like the cross or candle and being part of a church community. • Suggest questions such as: Why are Christians baptised? How are symbols used in church? What does it mean to belong to a faith family?	
SHOULD • Explain how Christians show they belong to their faith family • Understand how Christian symbols help people feel part of the faith family. • Explain how belonging to a faith family affects what Christians do	• Describe how Christians show they belong, such as through baptisms where they are welcomed into the church and become part of the Christian community • Explain what symbols show, such as water representing a fresh start, a candle representing belonging and the cross representing the Christian faith. • Give examples of how belonging affects actions, such as praying, going to church, making promises in baptism and being part of a church family	
COULD • Compare different ways Christians show belonging within Christianity. • Ask thoughtful questions about the meaning of belonging in a faith community • Justify how belonging to a faith family influences how Christians live	• Explain how belonging is shown in different ways, such as infant baptism and adult baptism, and how both show commitment to the Christian faith • Suggest questions such as: Why is belonging to a faith family important? How do symbols help people feel part of a group? Does belonging always look the same? • Give reasons why belonging influences actions, such as welcoming others, making promises, praying together and supporting the church community
